Decline & closure	• 21 <sup>st</sup> C hg rents & bus. rates > online shpg > out-of-town retail parks.
	• 2019 16,000 shops & 60,000 retail jobs gone.

Effects	• 10% of all bus. taxes & 25% of all bus. = Br. econ.
	• 20% GDP = this sector.
	<ul> <li>10.5% pop. &gt; 3M ppl. = £17.5 Bn taxes.</li> </ul>
	• Shop clos. = less money $\rightarrow$ treasury $\rightarrow$ public services $\rightarrow$ NHS $\rightarrow$ education
	→poor.
	• Empty shops = unappealing $\rightarrow$ less visitors $\rightarrow$ more shop closure $\rightarrow$ grim
